Reflect on personal spiritual experiences by doing building tours with the missionaries or a temple grounds visit.

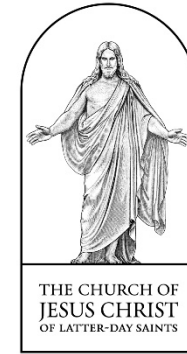
### Regular Reminders
